**Novices:** If you've never run an autocross before, a novice class will be running all day long. We will register and tech your car when you arrive during scheduled registration times.

**Safety:** You must wear an approved helmet (SNELL M2000 or SA2000 or better) in order to compete. Some loaner helmets are available, but are in short supply. Shoes are also required (no sandals, open toe shoes). Your car **MUST** be equipped with seatbelts and be in good working order (brakes, tires, etc.). No studded or temporary use tires. No loose objects in the car. No loose or bungee corded batteries, solid mount only. Noise restrictions are in place for this event, set at 92db @ 50 feet.

**Volunteers Needed:** If you are running in the morning and would like to help us set up the course, we start at 6:30 AM. For those running in the afternoon, we could use your help at cleanup. Your help is appreciated!!
